Suggested Cultural excursions

UMAG, ISTRIA

Istria, the largest Adriatic peninsula, is shared by Croatia, Slovenia, and Italy. The Croatian part, with a rich history and myriad islands and lagoons, is an increasingly popular tourist destination.

- Visit Porec, a medieval city famous for its beautiful beaches and fortified walls.
- See the fishing port of Rovinj and its traditional atmosphere.



VENICE - ITALY

- See St Mark's Square, Venice's principal square surrounded by incredible architecture, including St Mark's Basilica.
- See the famous Bridge of Sighs, which connected the old prison to the interrogation room.
- Visit the Correr Museum and discover the Art and History of Venice.
- Free time in Venice to wander around the city's endless mazes of backstreets and 150 canals.



MILAN

- Start your tour at the Duomo, the world's largest Gothic cathedral. Climb to the top to enjoy breathtaking views of the city. You can take the elevator or walk among the spires and statues.
- Don't miss the chance to see Da Vinci's "Last Supper" at the church of Santa Maria delle Grazie (Reservations need to be done months in advance).
- Take a stroll down Via Montenapoleone, Milan's fashionable shopping district.
- Visit Sforza Castle and explore the museums housed within, offering a diverse range of art and artifacts.
- Experience luxury shopping at Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, one of the world's oldest shopping malls.
- Visit San Siro Stadium, the home of AC Milan and Inter Milan.



LAKE COMO

- Take a tour of Como's walled city and ride the funicular to Brunate for a stunning view of Lake Como and the Alps.
- Take a boat ride from Bellagio to Varenna, a picturesque village known for its pastel-coloured houses.

BERGAMO

- Funicular ride from the modern part of the city “Citta Bassa” up to the Historic Center “Citta Alta”.
- Visit the heart of the Old City, Piazza Vecchia. Climb up the 1000-year-old Bell Tower once used to warn citizens about the closing of the city’s gates.
- See the impressive ornamentations of the Basilica di Santa Maria Maggiore.
- Walk along the Fortified Venetian Walls from the “Citta Alta” to “Citta Bassa”.

VERONA AND GARDA LAKE

- Visit of Sirmione, a fortified town and its picturesque castle dating from the 13th century.
- Discover the Arena of Verona, a well-preserved ancient Rome amphitheater renowned for its open-air operas.
- Walk to Juliet’s House in the center of Verona, the supposed location of the balcony love scene from Shakespeare’s Romeo and Juliet.
